
OBJECTIVE 1

To develop, pilot and contribute to non-for-profit projects with the aim of advancing sustainable research and innovation, particularly in the areas of climate change, biodiversity and sustainable agriculture, circular economy, and sustainable and inclusive cities.

Objective 1 focuses on LGI's non-profit activities - developing, piloting and contributing to projects that advance sustainable research and innovation in Europe and the world, in alignment with planetary boundaries. In 2024 LGI strengthened its commitment, with the team contributing to **53 publicly funded projects** and actively supporting the **development of climate services across Africa**.



All four business units in LGI contributed to this sustainable non-profit work, and a majority of the non-profit projects we worked on included at least three out of four business units working together.



LGI's commitments in Africa

Supporting Agroforestry in Malawian Schools

In 2023, LGI funded three elementary schools in Malawi's Zomba District to establish environmental clubs and agroforestry food gardens addressing child food insecurity. Concluding in 2024, the project delivered a tree nursery, 9,000 nitrogen-fixing trees, and 800 fruit trees. Results showed strong community support for fruit planting and highlighted ongoing needs to integrate agroforestry into farming practices. LGI remains engaged with partners in Malawi to build on these lessons.



Advancing climate resilience and sustainable energy innovation

LGI strengthens Africa - Europe cooperation to accelerate the green transition, reinforce climate resilience, and expand access to sustainable energy. Through initiatives such as **LEAP-RE** and **FOCUS Africa**, LGI supports bi-continental research, innovation, and capacity building linking science, policy, and communities. LGI's work advances clean energy technologies and prepares high-potential solutions for scales up through a dedicated Start-up Studio, while delivering climate services and promoting equal partnerships and Open Science. **Through its non-profit projects LGI supports continental goals such as Mission 300, Agenda 2063, and sustainable electricity access across Africa.**

IID-SII Sustainable Innovation Institute

IID-SII is the non-profit entity established in 2019 by LGI with the mission to advance and foster knowledge on nature-based solutions, biodiversity, soil and the circular economy. With a team of 3 experts in project management, strategy and communication, IID-SII is active on 4 European projects: **NBRACER**, **SOILCRATES**, **EXCEED** and now also **BIOSAFIRE**.



In 2024, LGI enters a new strategic phase towards more impact on the field with the reflection about setting-up a corporate foundation dedicated to biodiversity protection.

OBJECTIVE 2

Share knowledge around issues and solutions, through a policy of public and royalty-free communication of project results, data and analysis.

In 2024, LGI's new projects created fresh communication and dissemination opportunities, while long-standing initiatives continued to build recognition and visibility - together driving a significant increase in LGI's audience.




OBJECTIVE 3

In the services delivered by the Company, advise and support clients in adapting their business model and developing growth opportunities in line with sustainable innovation.

LGI's commitment to supporting clients in reshaping their business models and unlocking growth aligned with environmental and societal objectives remained strong - with a notable increase in funding and project setups this year.



LGI's impact is driven by a balanced portfolio of activities that combine strategic funding, innovation leadership, and capacity-building to accelerate sustainable change.



OBJECTIVE 4

Limit the carbon footprint directly attributable to all projects and missions, for the company and its stakeholders, and being a great place to work.

For the second consecutive year, LGI's carbon footprint across Scopes 1-3 is being assessed by **Greenly**, using a hybrid activity-based and spend-based methodology, with results expected in early 2026. Meanwhile, updates to LGI's ESG Charter and Dashboard based on the preliminary results available ensure policies and initiatives reduce environmental impact while supporting workplace wellbeing.

Decarbonisation roadmap

LGI decarbonisation roadmap focuses on defining clear and measurable reduction targets for Scopes 1 and 2 by 2026, while identifying priority levers for reducing Scope 3 emissions, notably **employee travel, energy optimisation, office infrastructure, and digital activity**. The roadmap will be finalised once the 2024 footprint is completed, enabling LGI to set a coherent trajectory toward its Net Zero ambition and to integrate decarbonisation measures into internal policies and operational practices.

ESG Framework: CSR Charter and Dashboard

In 2024, LGI significantly strengthened its ESG framework by formalising three key internal deliverables designed to structure, measure, and communicate the company's sustainability commitments:

- **CSR Charter:** A consolidated document outlining LGI's ESG commitments, aligned with its Mission Statement, the UN Global Compact, LGI's four **Transition Hubs**, and used for internal guidance and external communication.
- **Annual ESG Dashboard:** A quantitative tool tracking key environmental, social, and governance indicators year over year to support transparency and performance management.
- **CSR Actions Log:** A long-term record of CSR initiatives since 2005, supporting progress tracking, institutional memory, and future reporting.

Together, these tools establish a **coherent and operational ESG governance system** that supports continuous improvement, facilitates stakeholder communication, and embeds sustainability across LGI's activities.
